Grace Melodia Toronto (多倫多頌恩旋律) is excited and grateful to resume our mission road trip after the pandemic. From November 15-17, 2024, our team will travel to Montreal to host four evangelistic meetings in partnership with five local Montreal churches.

Since the fall of 2023, we have been in ongoing conversations, seeking gospel collaboration with these five local churches. These conversations have been fruitful and essential, as they allow us to understand the local changes and needs. Since then, our team, along with local church leaders, has been praying earnestly for the Lord's guidance on the next steps.

The new gospel program we will launch is titled "Healing in the Psalms" (詩中的療愈). The inspiration arises from the continuous encounters and reflections of serious and terminal illnesses. Numerous Montreal and Toronto Christians, whom we have interviewed both digitally and in person, have shared their faith journeys through the "dark valleys" of their lives. Both patients and caregivers have vividly experienced the presence and unfailing promises of the Living God, even during their toughest days.

With respect to the program details, Grace Melodia Toronto is humbled by the affirmation from local pastors and church leaders who are eager to collaborate actively. As such, these partners in Christ are involved in both the planning and promotion process, as well as forming a local joint choir to serve alongside our music and worship team. Additionally, we are organizing a short drama focused on faith and terminal illness to further emphasize the message that God is our faithful Rescuer and Redeemer.
